



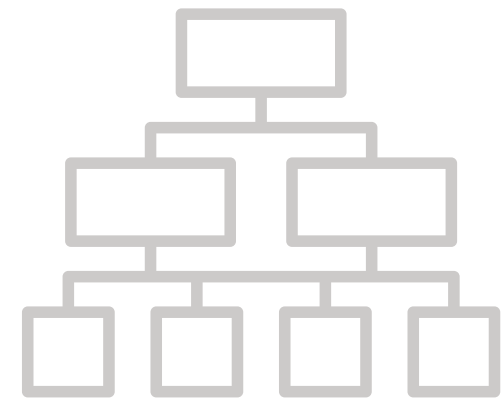

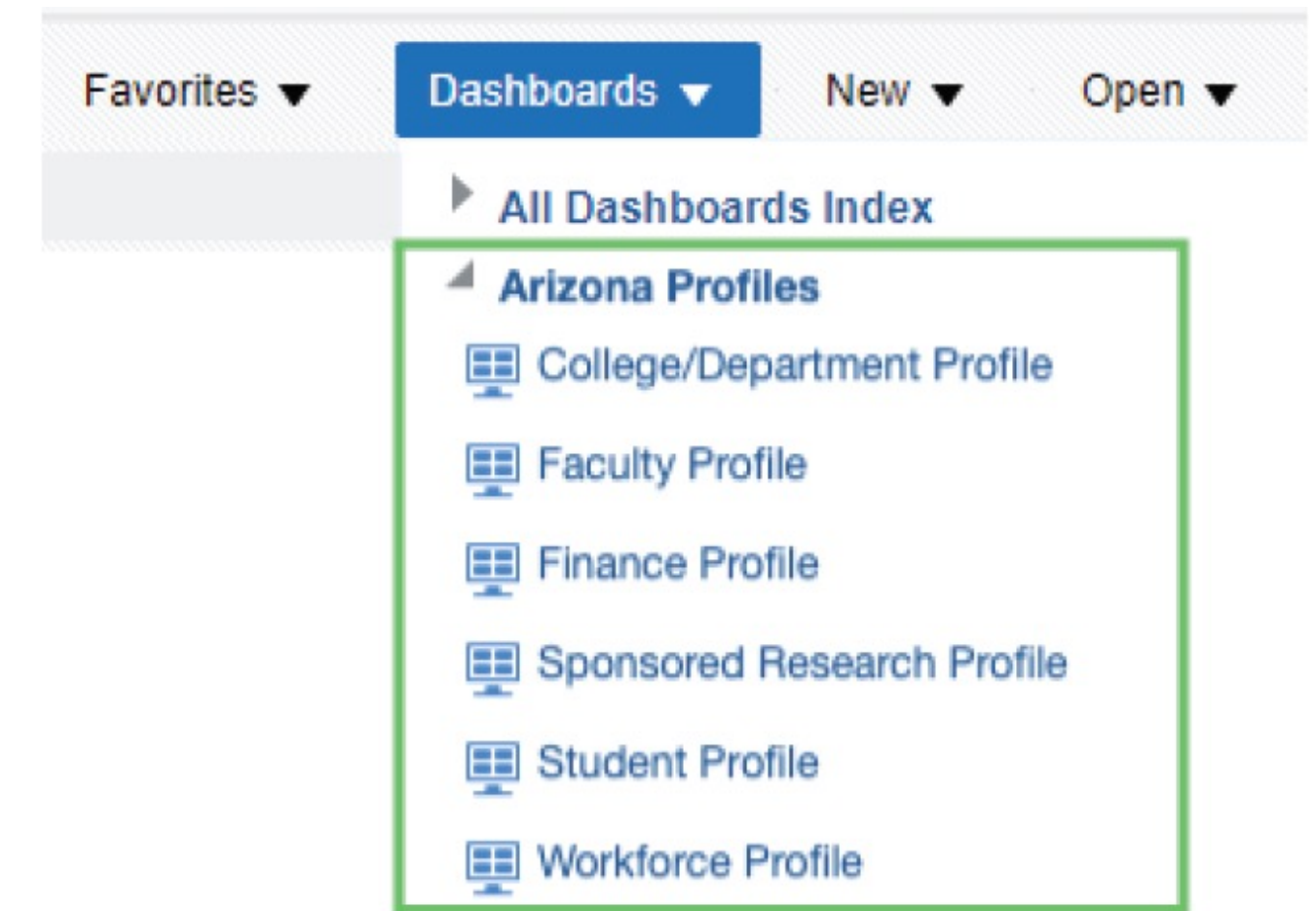

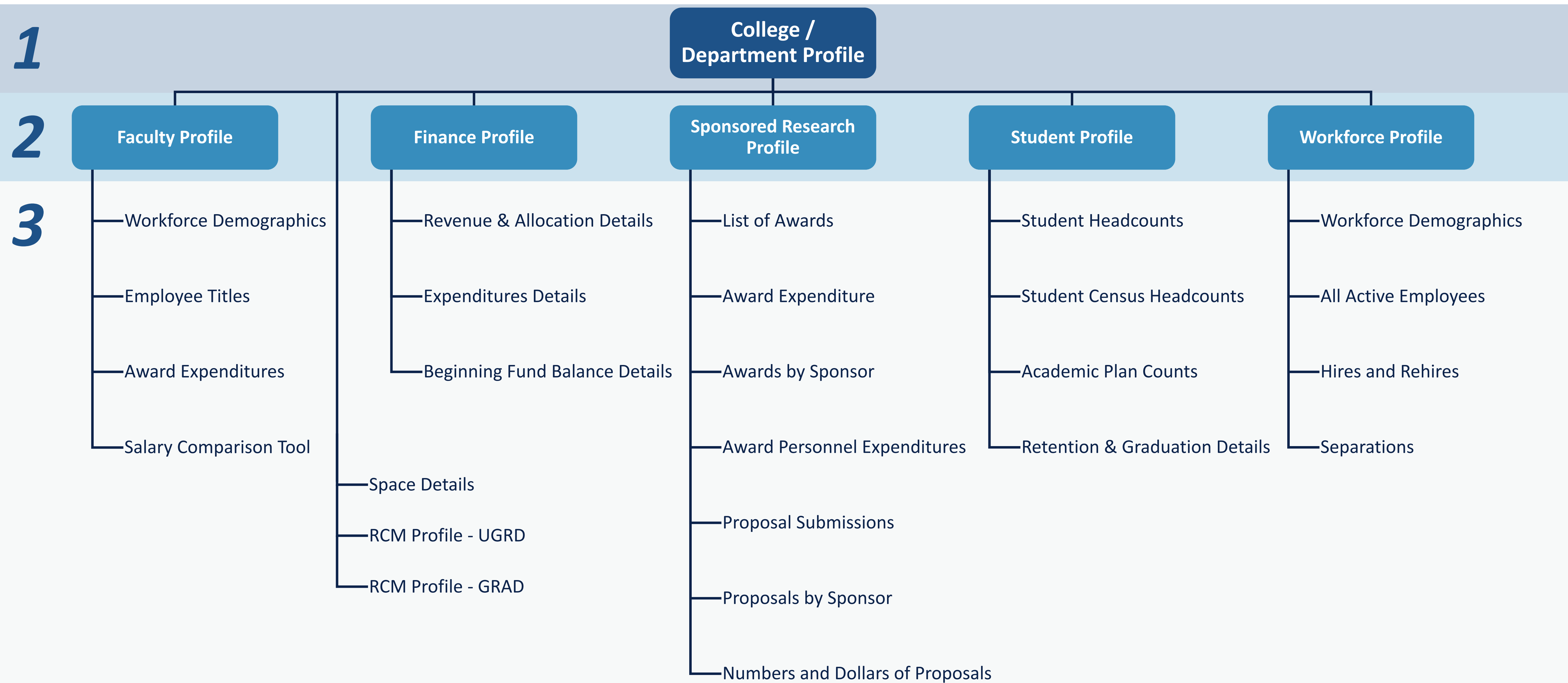

THREE LEVELS OF DETAIL



What is the difference between college, budget department, and department?



College

These can be academic or operational units within the university.



Budget Department

Units that are considered “official” as they exist as part of the budget. This makes them a reliable organization to review data across different UAccess Enterprise Systems.



Department

Units that may or may not be part of the budget. These may be considered “unofficial” organizations as some UAccess Enterprise Systems can define their own and the subsets don’t overlap from system to system.

College/Department Hierarchy

College/Department Hierarchy

The organizational hierarchy was created to bring data together from different UAccess Enterprise Systems (Financials, Student, Employee, Space, Research). **Department** is the lowest “level” in the organizational hierarchy and may be considered an “unofficial” organization as UAccess Enterprise Systems can define their own and the subsets don’t overlap from system to system. The **Budget Department** has been found to be the most consistent across the aforementioned systems and is often used to reliably compare data across operational areas. What are the two most common types of student counts?



Student Headcount

Unique student counts

A student will be counted only once based on their primary major, which will align with externally reported figures.

VS



Academic Plan Count

Active plans

A student will be counted in every plan they are active in. This means possibly multiple times within the same department or college.

What is an enrolled student vs a student with an active plan?



Active Plan Status

A student has an active status, allowing them to enroll in a term and be evaluated for transfer credit.

VS



Enrollment Status

A student has an active status and is enrolled in more than one unit in the specified term.

Students are active in plans and they enroll in courses.

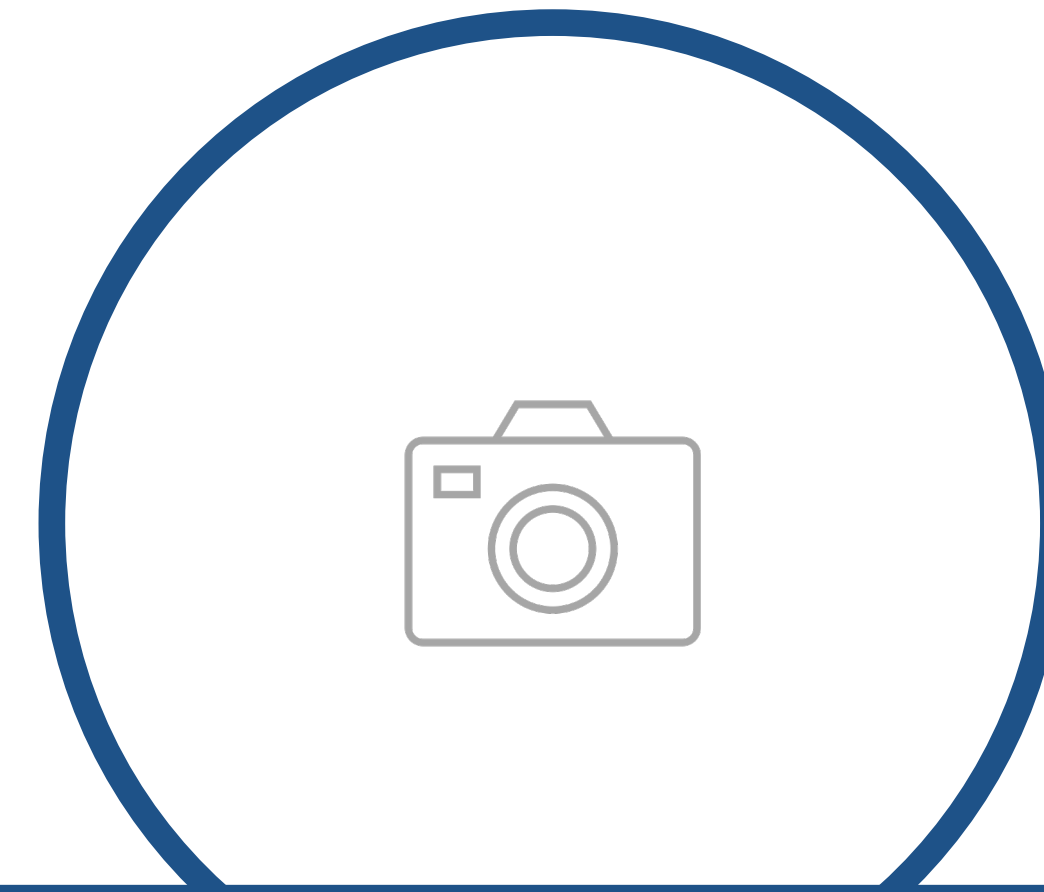


Current Data

Matches Current Data from UAccess Student

This data is refreshed nightly from the UAccess Student system. Current data can change daily.

Snapshot Data

Point-in-time Data from UAccess Student

This data is fixed to a specific date and time. Snapshots contain data that is frozen in time and does not change.



STUDENT HEADCOUNT PROFILE

Counts a student once in their primary plan, as a unique student count, and breaks these counts out by academic career, academic level, program campus, residency, sex and IPEDS race/ethnicity for both graduates and undergraduates.

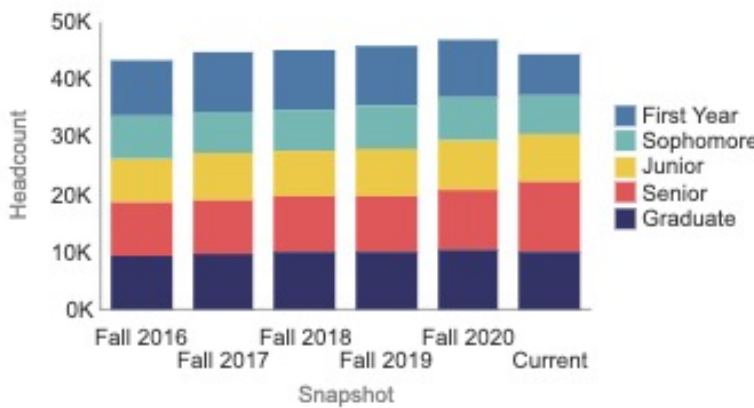

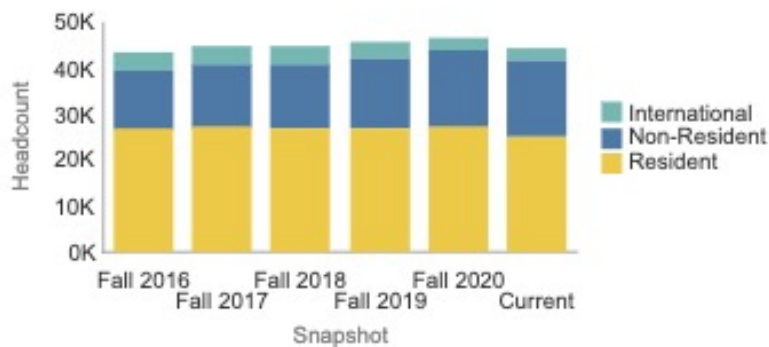

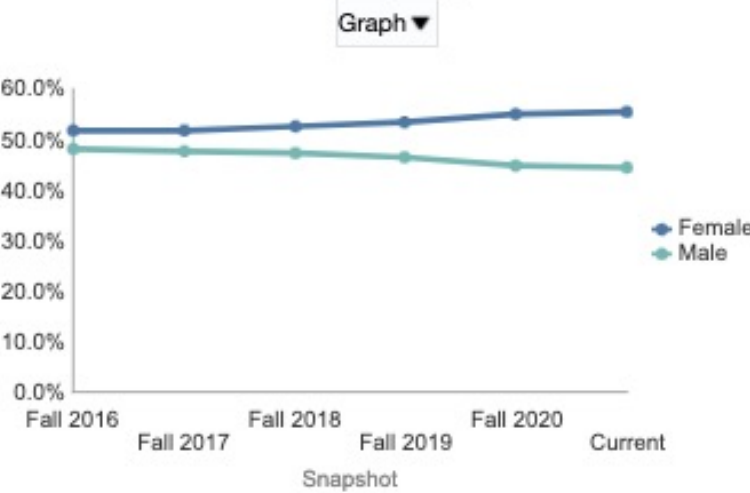
Headcount by Residency

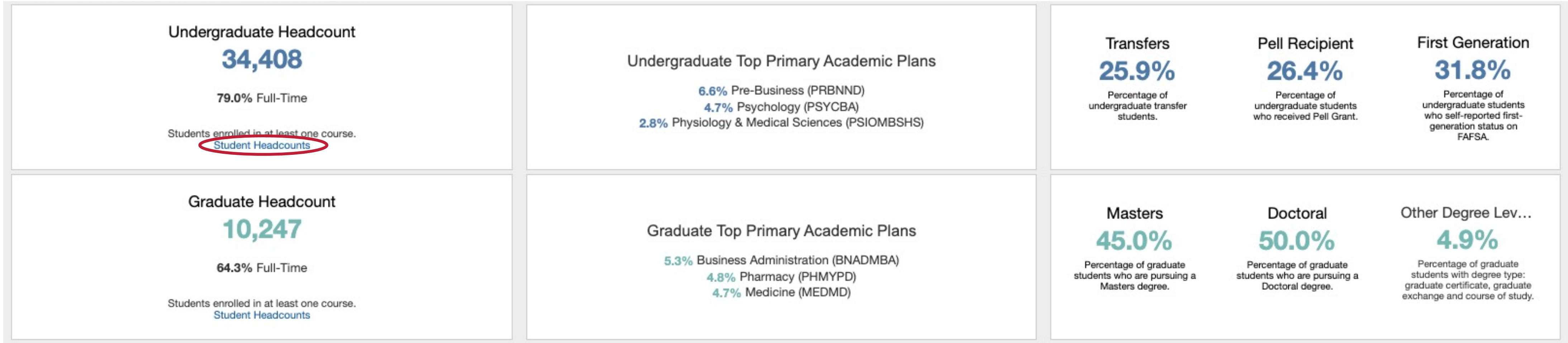

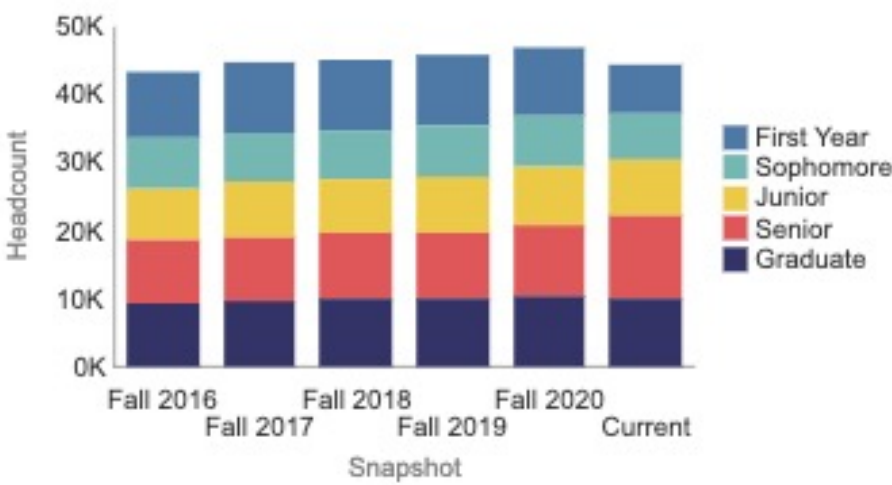

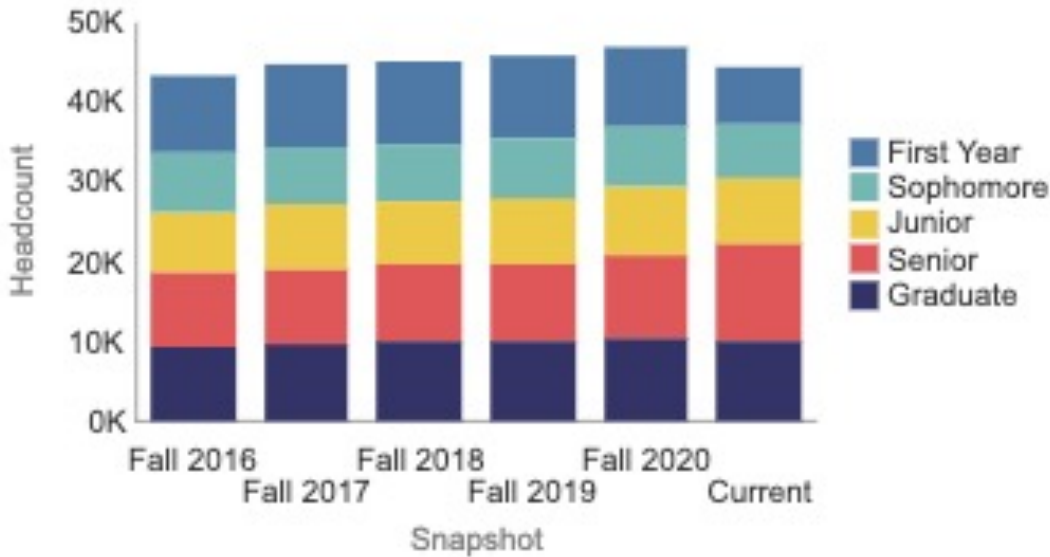

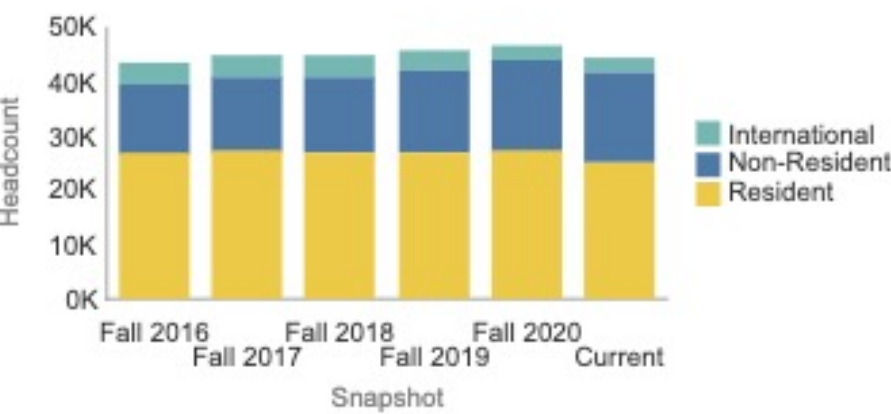

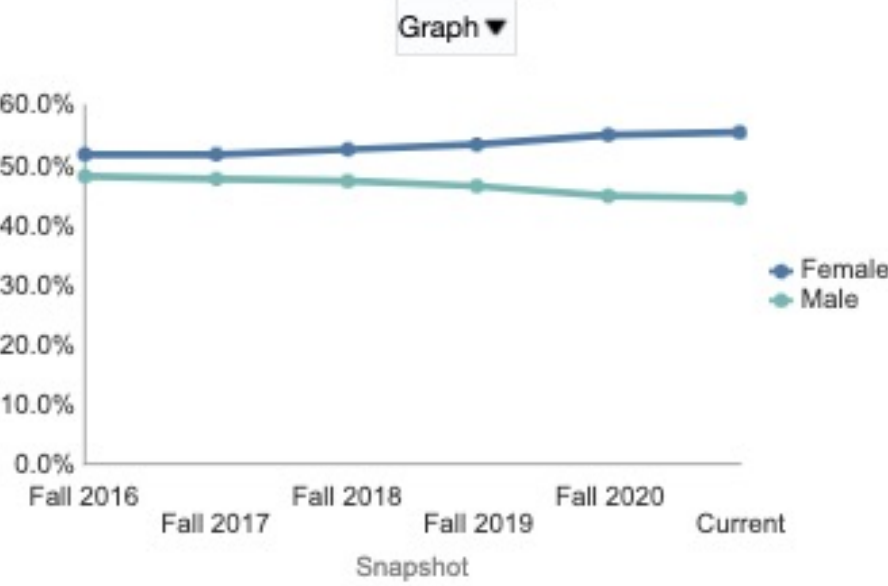

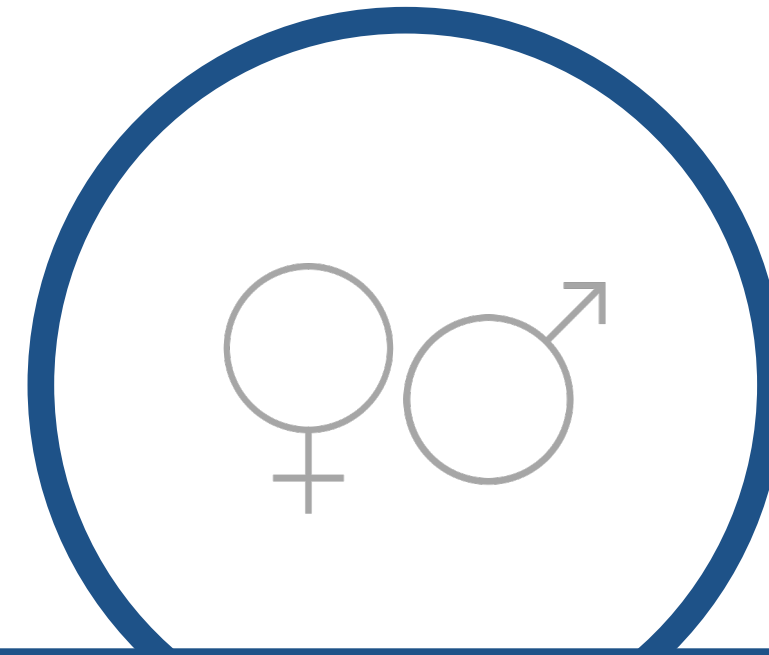

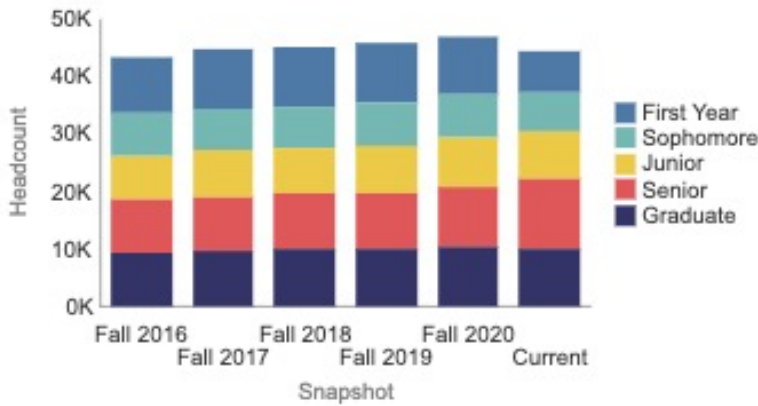

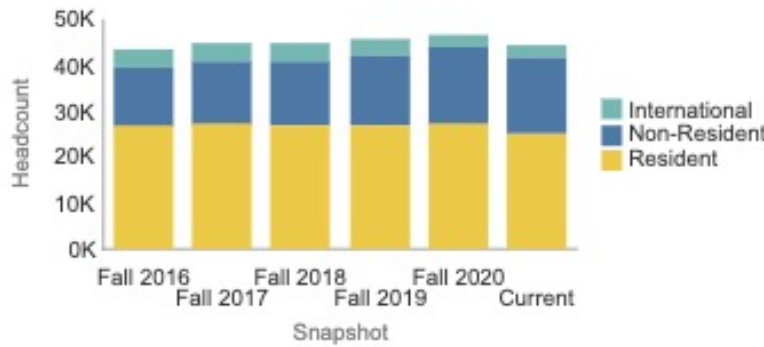

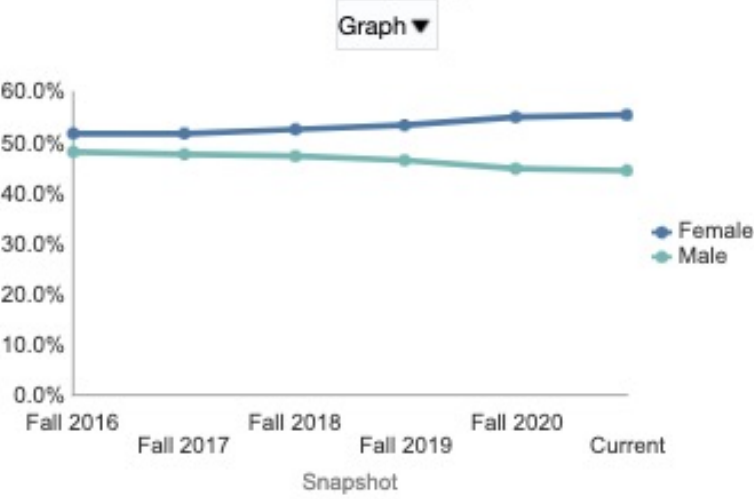

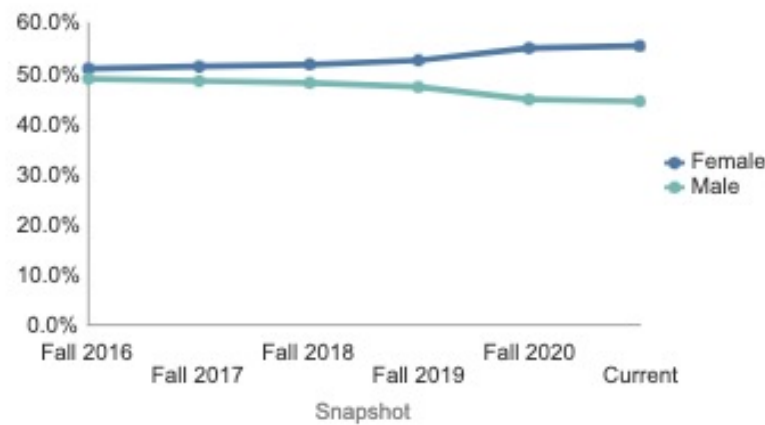

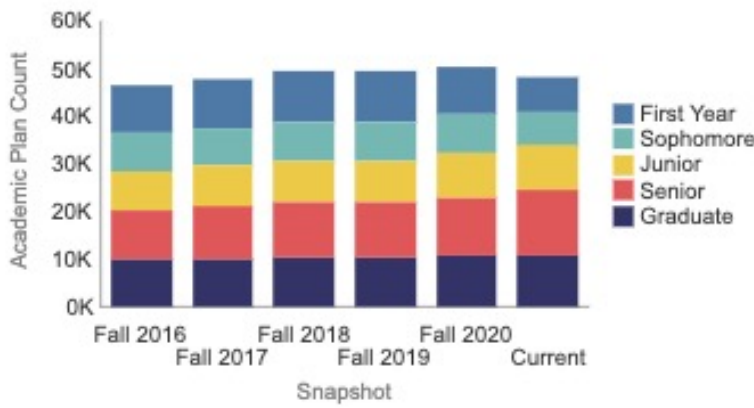

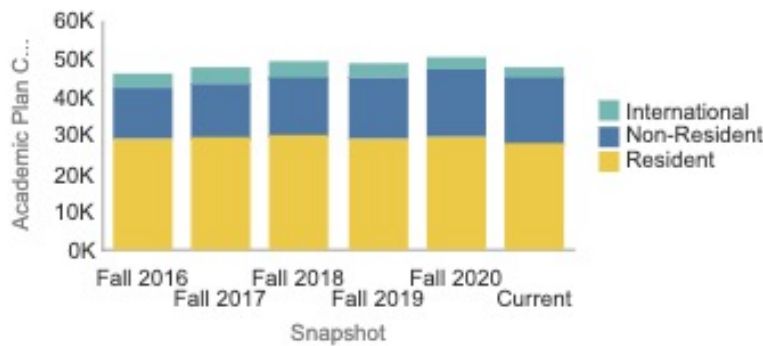

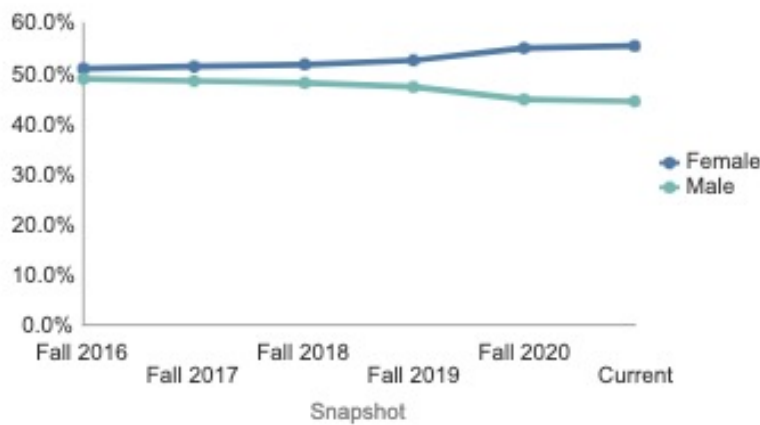

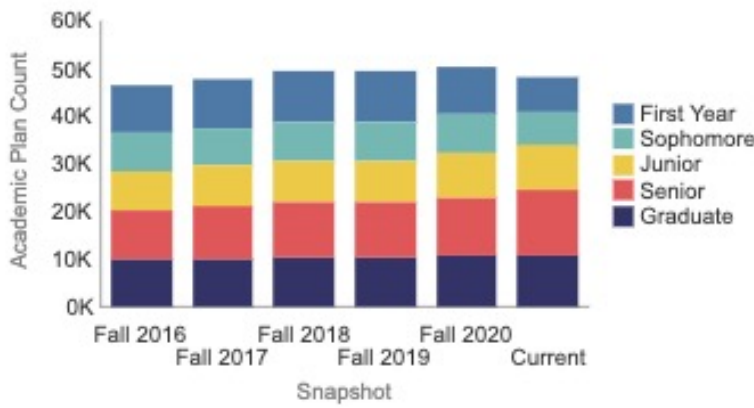

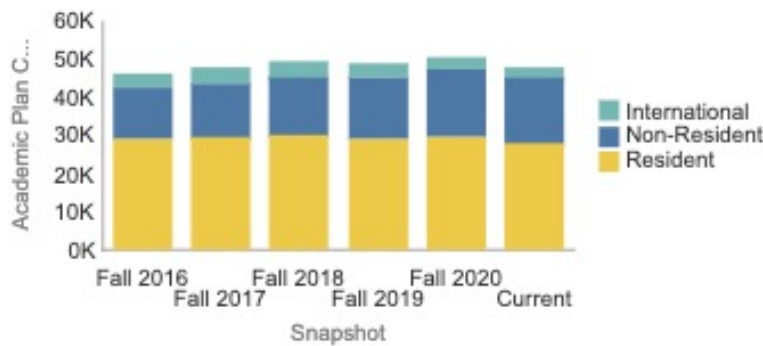

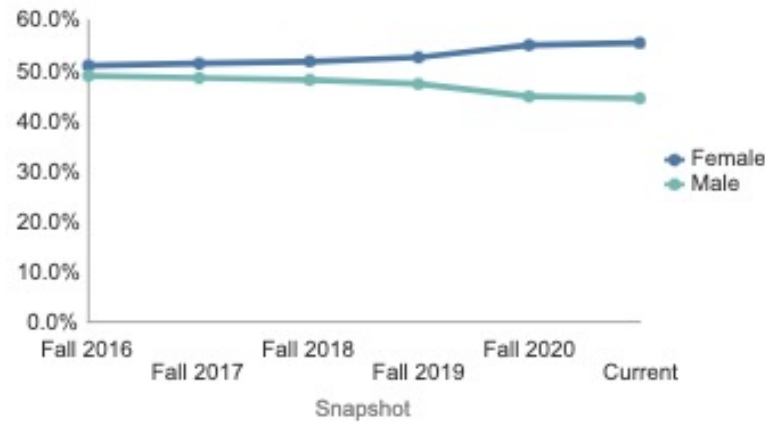

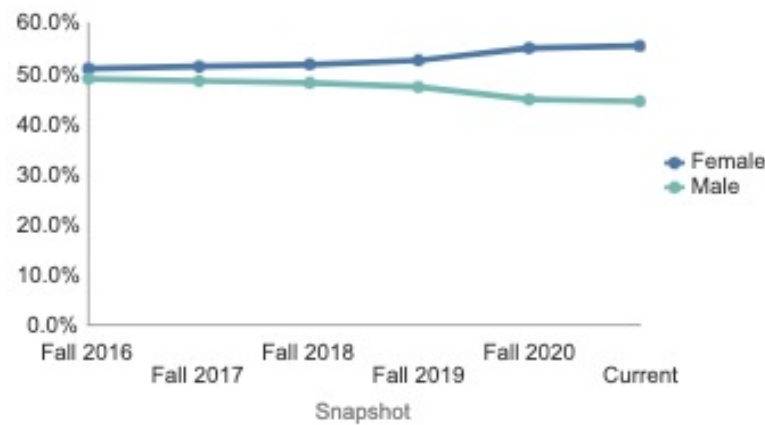

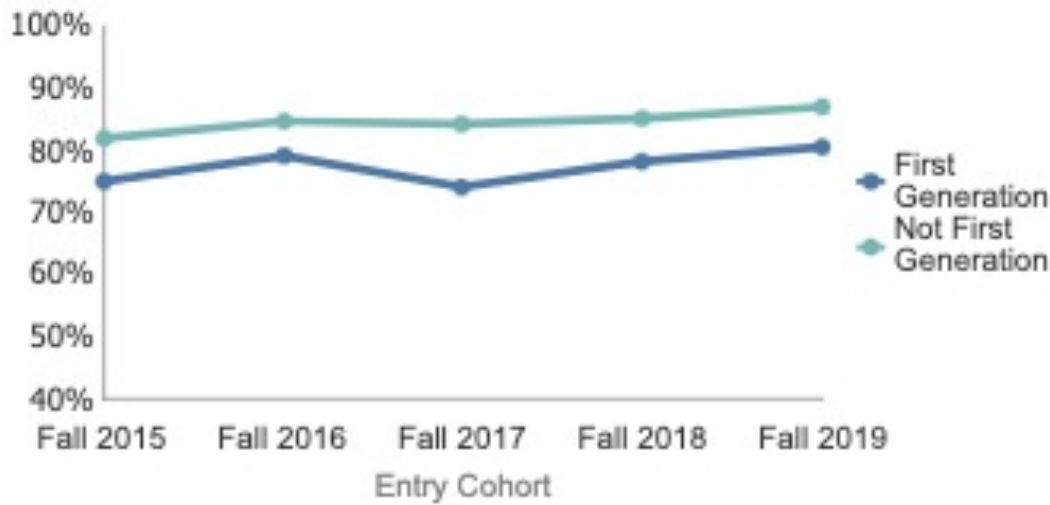

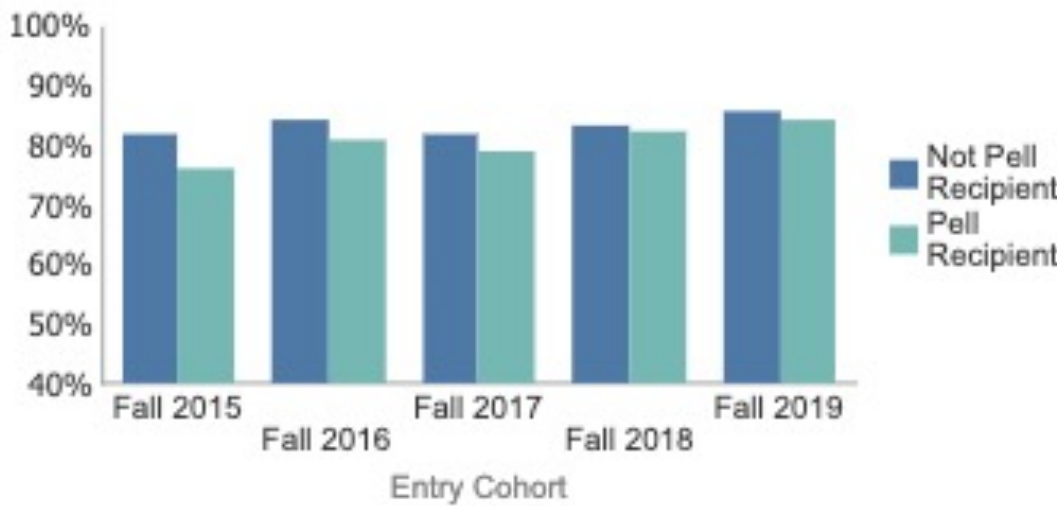

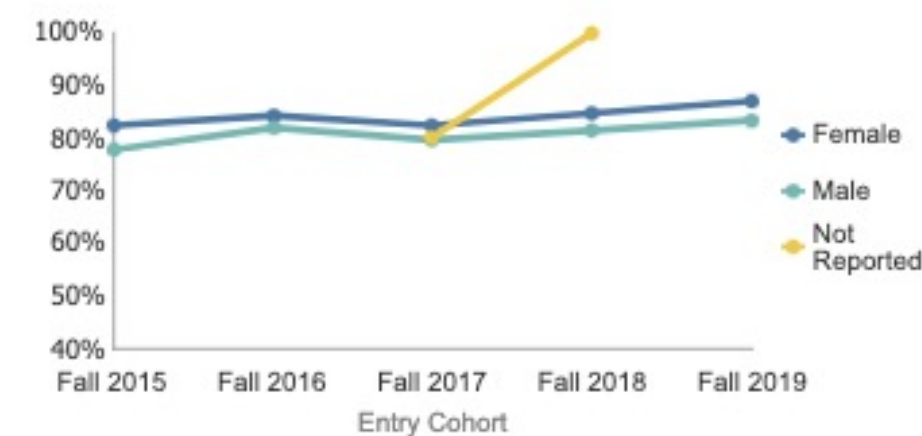
